West Downs Neighbourhood Watch Task Force

Members of the West Downs Neighbourhood Watch Task Force were delighted to be honoured at a reception at Worthing Town Hall, hosted by Her Worship the Mayor of Worthing Councillor Henna Choudhury and Councillor Andy McGregor, Chairman of Adur District Council, in recognition of the Force's services to the communities in the Adur Districts and Worthing Borough. These included the marshalling support and expertise that the team provided at the Remembrance Services held in the Adur Districts and Worthing Borough during this and in former years.

Owing to occasions such as these, with the Platinum Jubilee and the Royal Proclamations following the accession of HRH King Charles 111, the Task Force covered more events this year than usual, 27 to date, with the last one being at Lancing Chapel on the 18th December. Somehow, we have always managed to find volunteers for these events - which included three firework displays, three road races and three parades, including the Worthing Carnival – and we are naturally grateful to all those of our members who turned out in support, whatever the weather or time of day or night.

Task Force members have also been active in helping with bike-marking services which makes bikes easier to trace when stolen, and providing advice as to the use of suitable locks – D-locks may be heavier but they are much more effective than cable locks.

Meanwhile, a new crowdfunding scheme - Fund our Food Banks - has been set up to help people in Adur and Worthing who are struggling to afford enough food to get by this winter. This is a joint project between Adur and Worthing Food Network, Adur & Worthing Councils and Community Works, a local organisation that supports the voluntary sector.

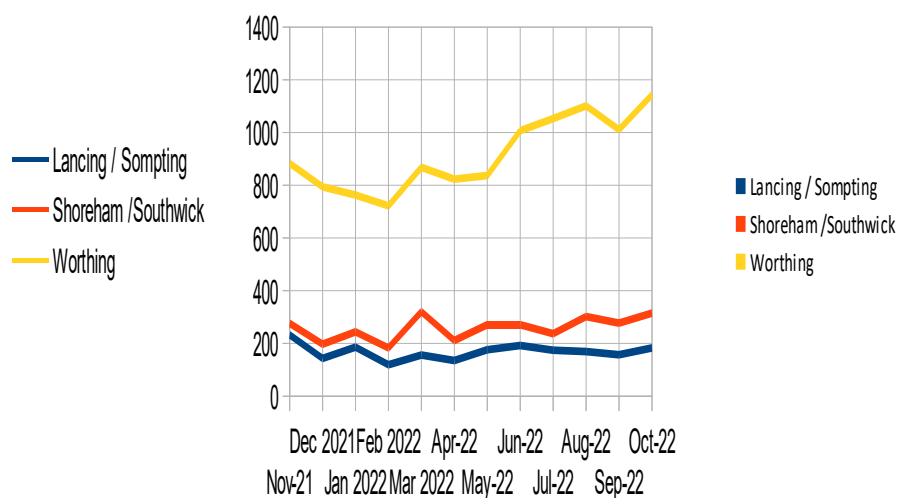

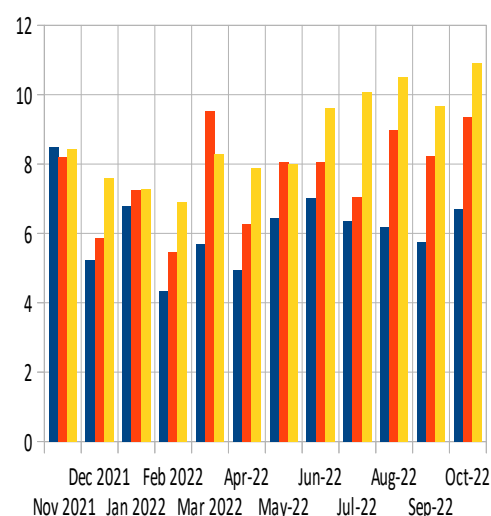
